Key Concepts: TENSES- STEM-CHANGING VERBS IN THE PRESENT TENSE.

The Present tense is used to talk about actions and events that are happening or that do happen regularly. Read how to form and use the present tense of -ar, -er and -ir verbs and stem-changing verbs here:

Verb: **preferir (To prefer)**

prefiero – I prefer

prefieres – you prefer

prefiere – he/she/it prefers

preferimos – we prefer
preferís – You prefer(pl)

prefieren – they prefer

Verb: **doler (To hurt)**

Me duele – it hurts (me)

Te duele – it hurts (you)

Le duele – it hurts (him, her, them)

Me duelen – it hurts me (plural)

Verb: **Jugar (To play)**

Juego – I play

jugamos = we play

Juegas = you play

Jugáis – you play (pl)

Juega – he/she/it plays

juegan – they play
